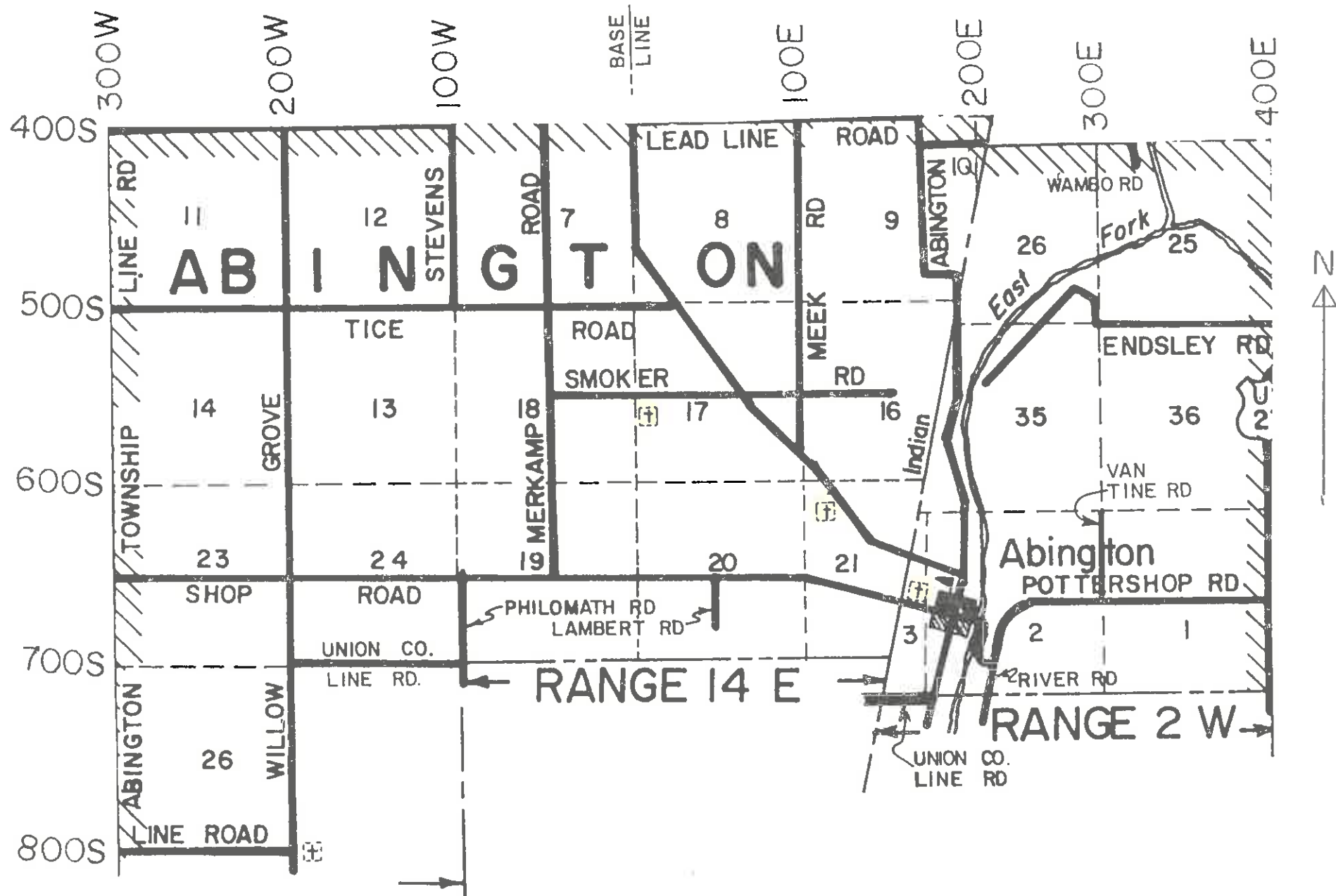

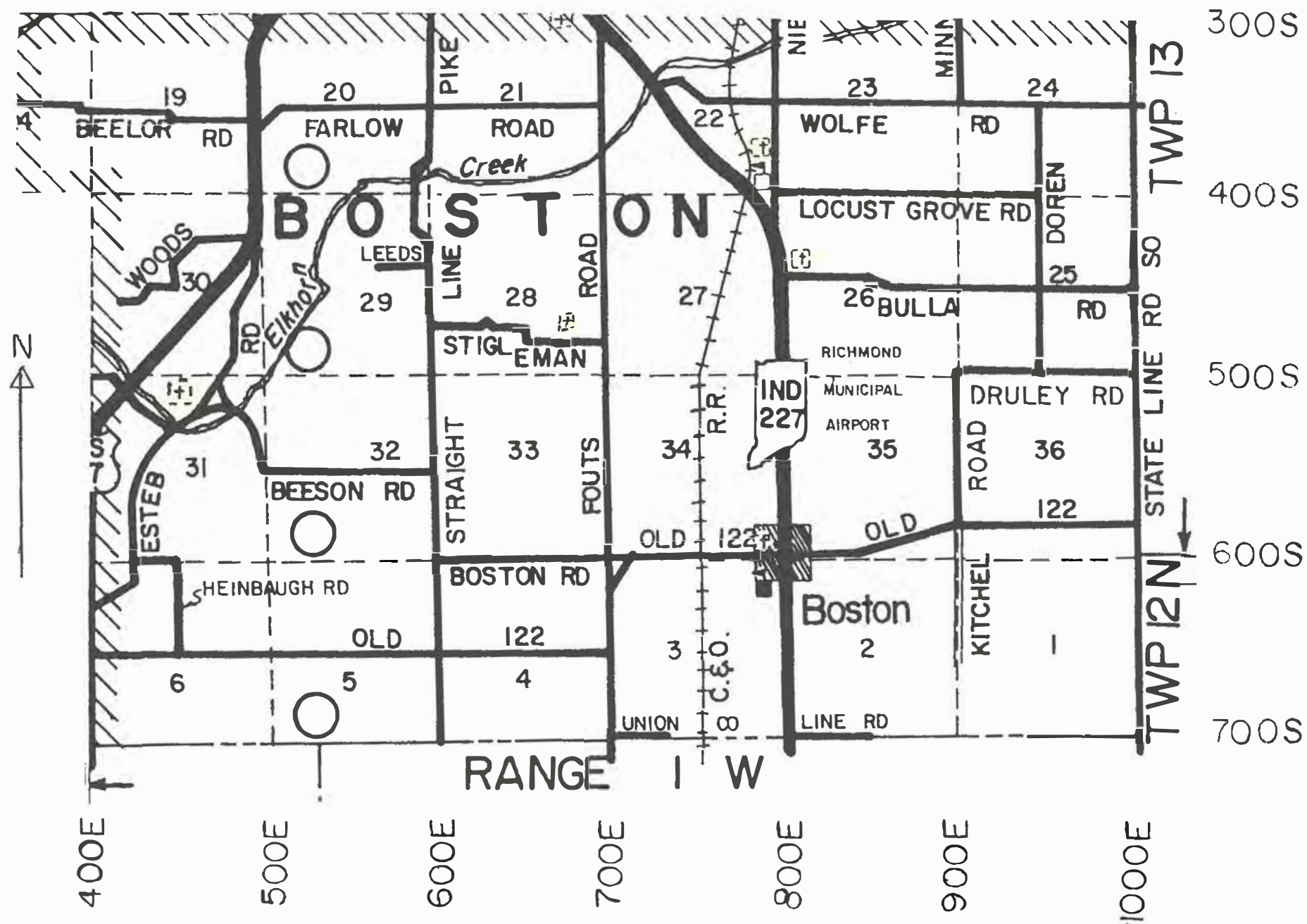

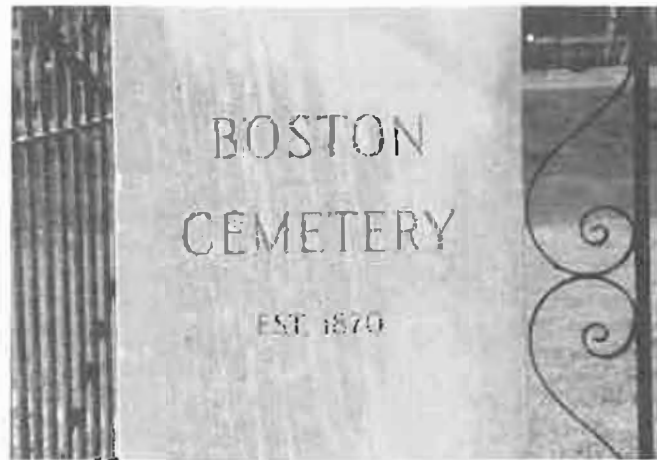

Location--North side of Stigleman Road, west of 4947 Fouts Road, northwest of Boston.

Directions--From Boston: go west on Old IND #122, go right (north) on Fouts Road, then go left (west) on Stigleman Road about .2 mile. Cemetery is about 300 feet into the field on the right side.

If corn is growing in this field, the cemetery may not be visible from the road. There are a few trees around the cemetery.

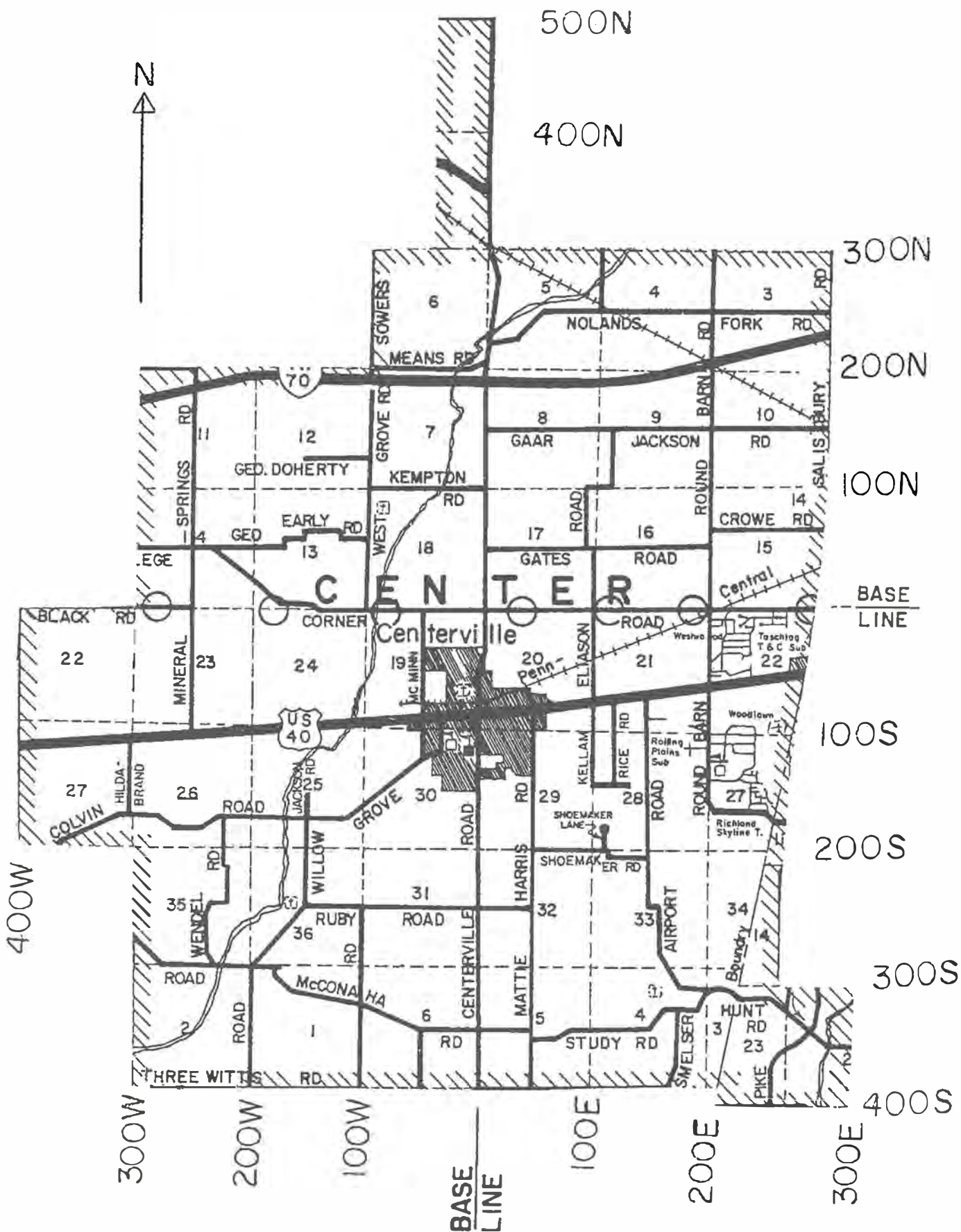

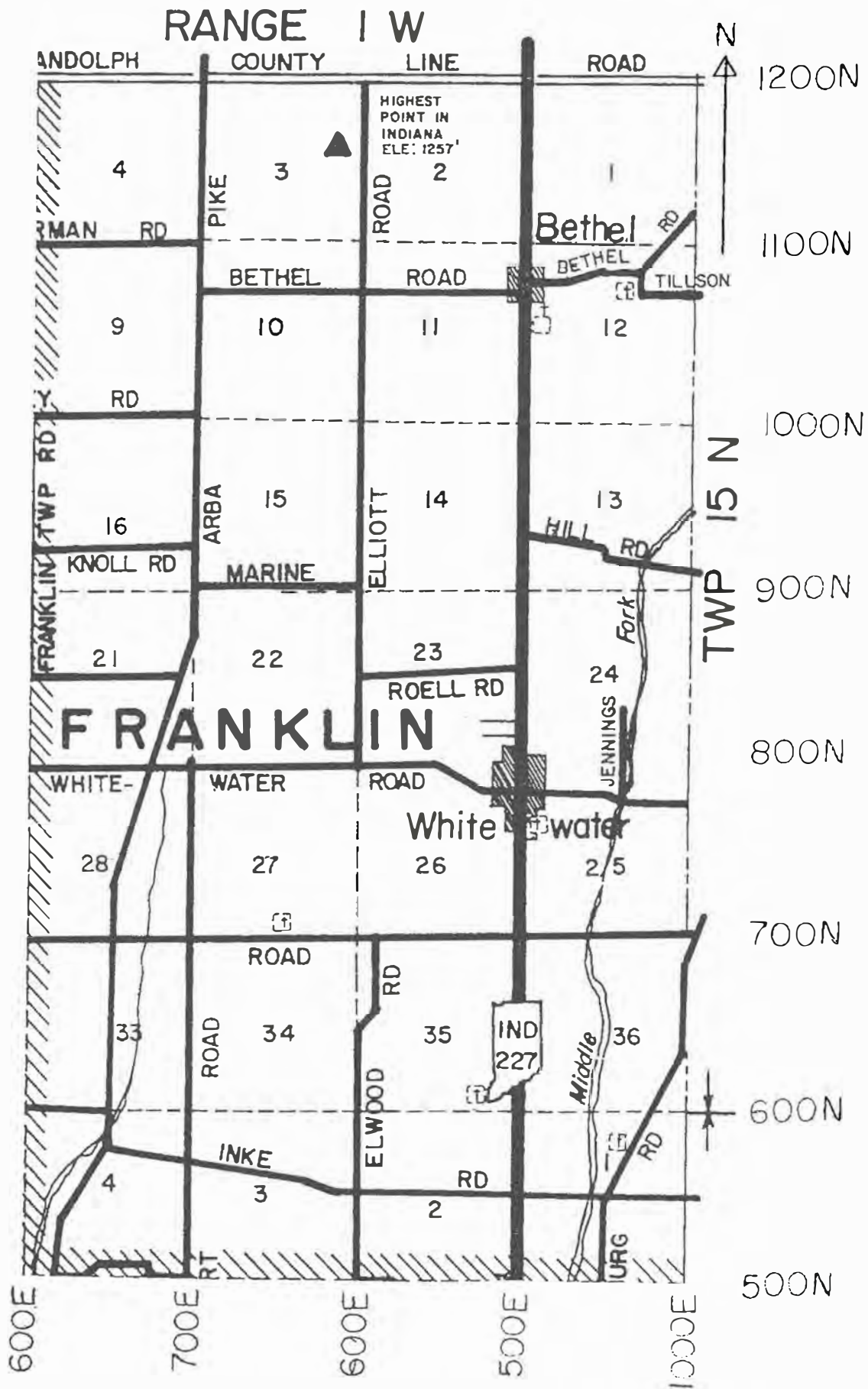

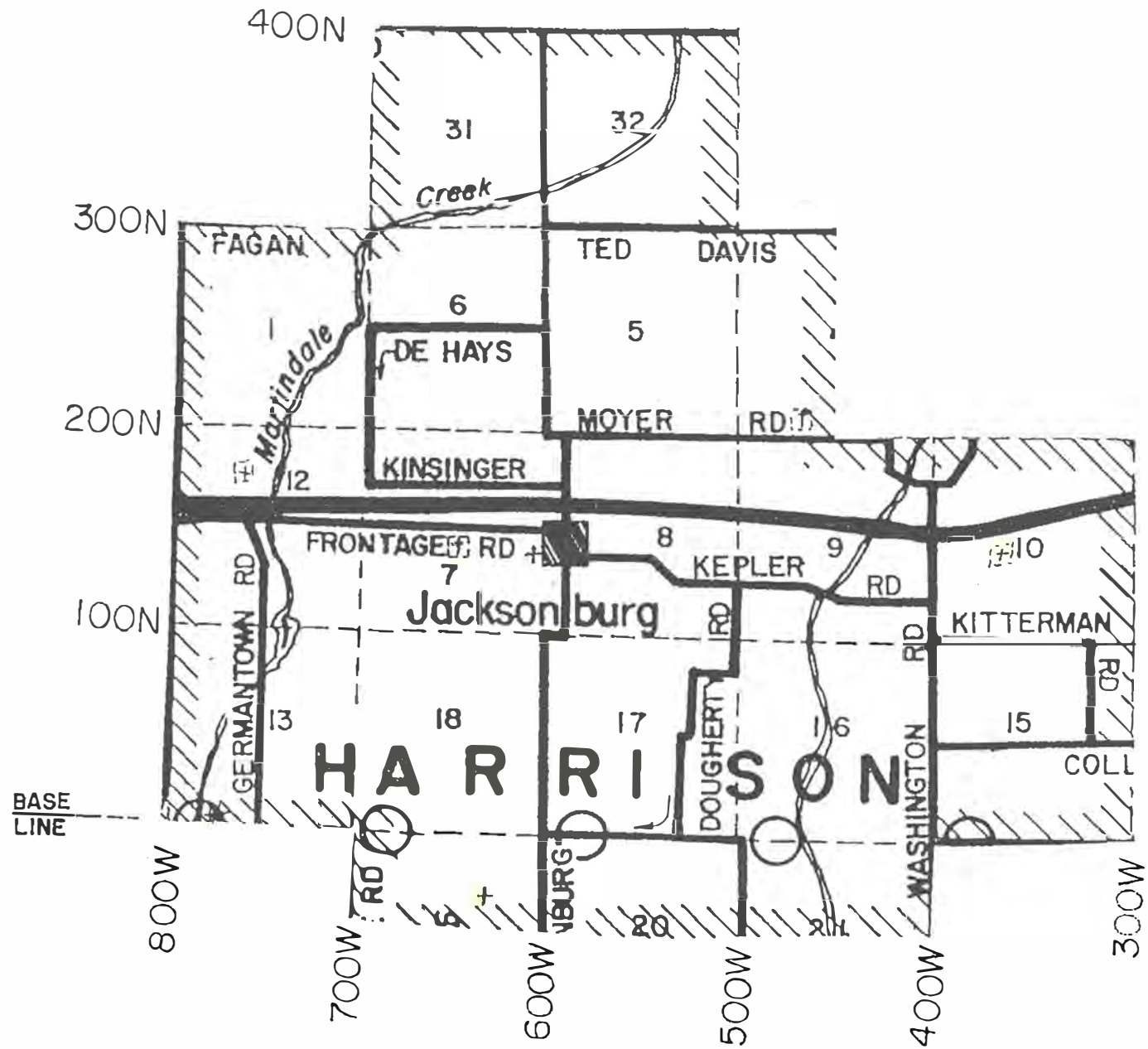

I was informed later, that if a person follows a straight line-directly east from Goose Heaven Road, at St. Rd. #1--which would be following a natural, small depression in the ground (where the high power line goes east)--into the woods, and across Martindale Creek (wade the creek), the cemetery would be just north of this line, on a high bank on the east side of the creek. At one time, there was a stone wall around the cemetery.

The natural small depression, mentioned in the above paragraph, is the line of an old wagon road which was in use back around the time of the use of this cemetery.

On the east side of the creek, I was not able to determine exactly where to enter the woods, to locate the cemetery, as the woods stretch along the east side for about a 1500 foot length, with no natural opening, and probably about 400 feet from the creek.

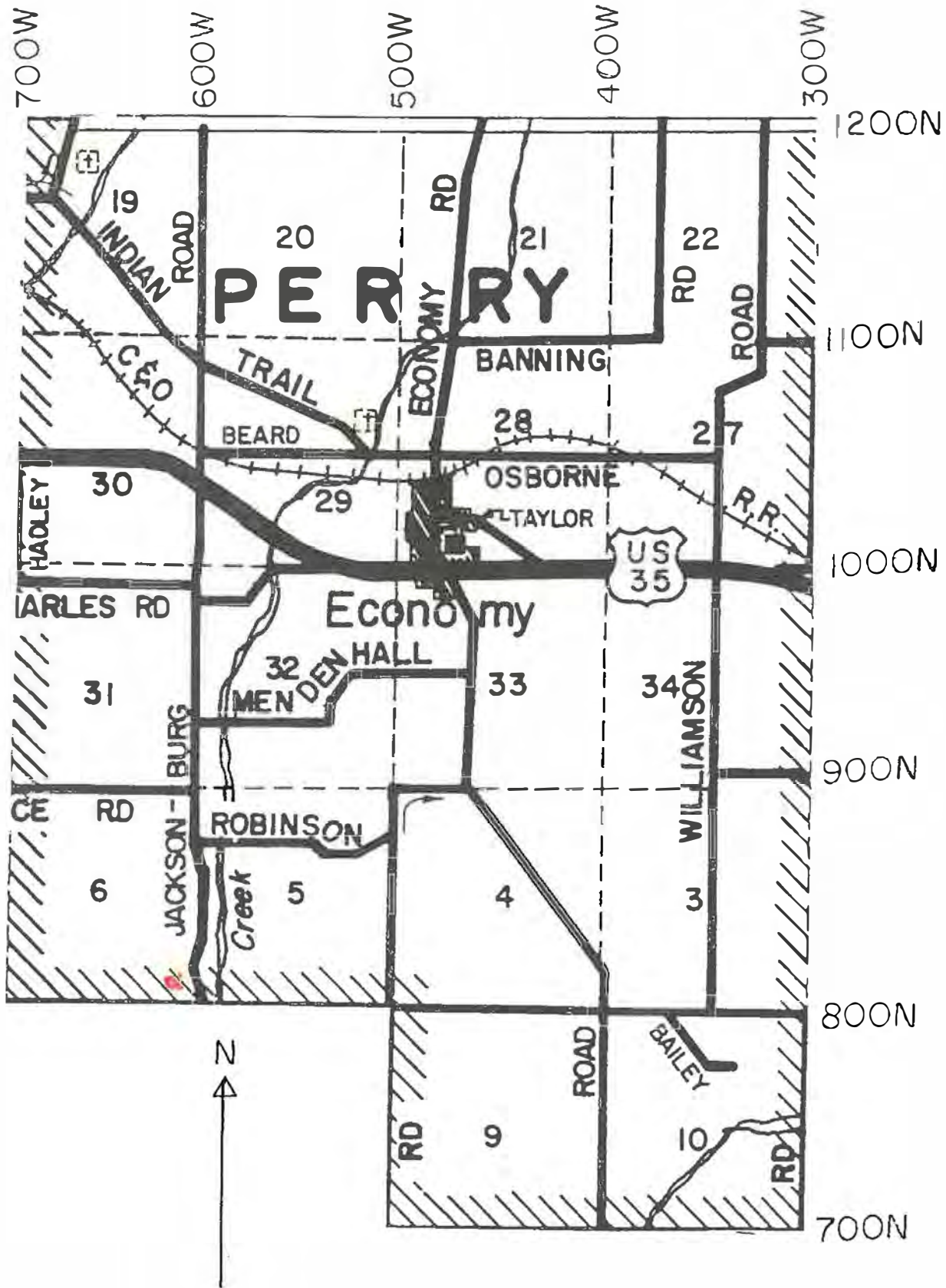

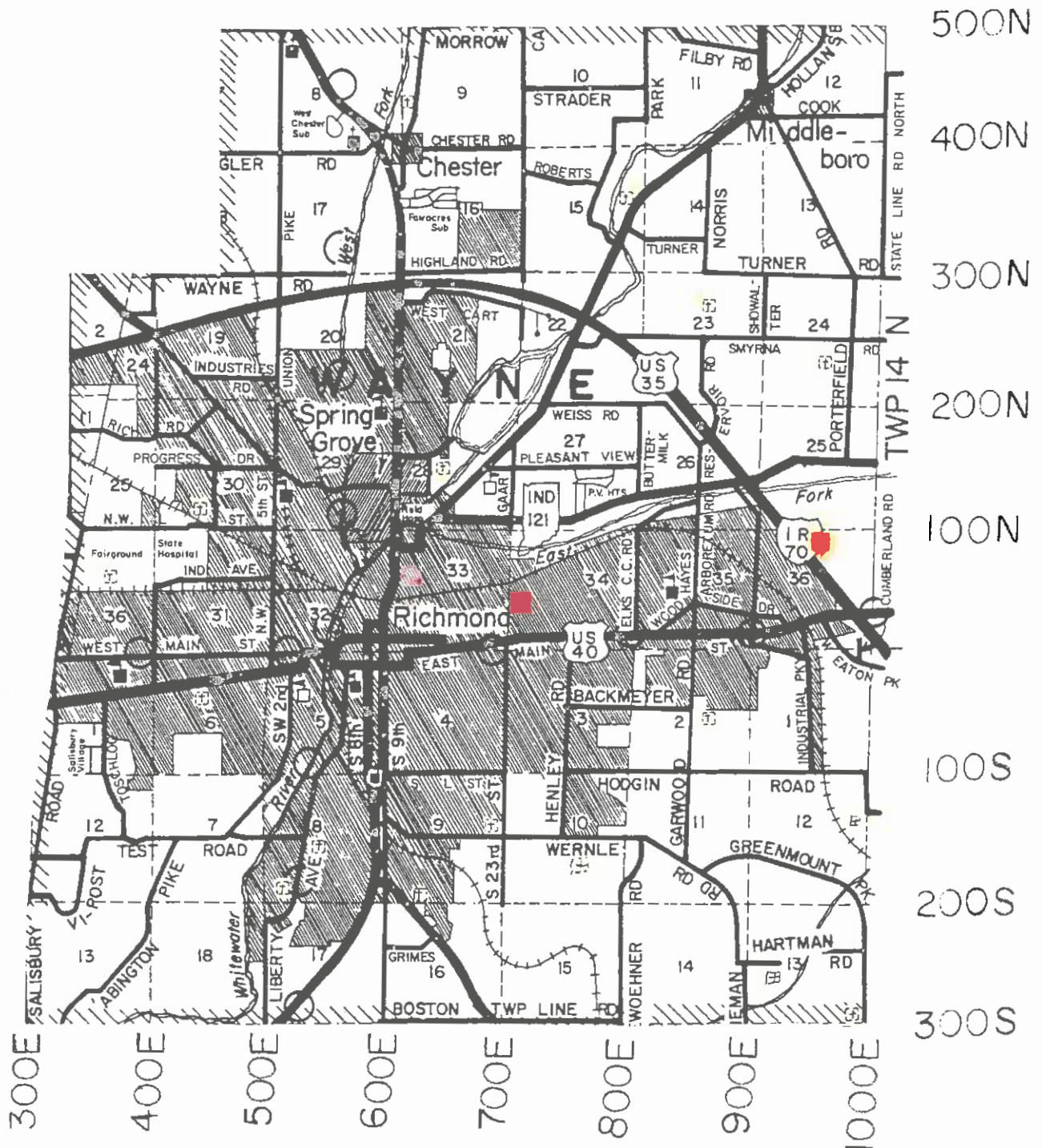

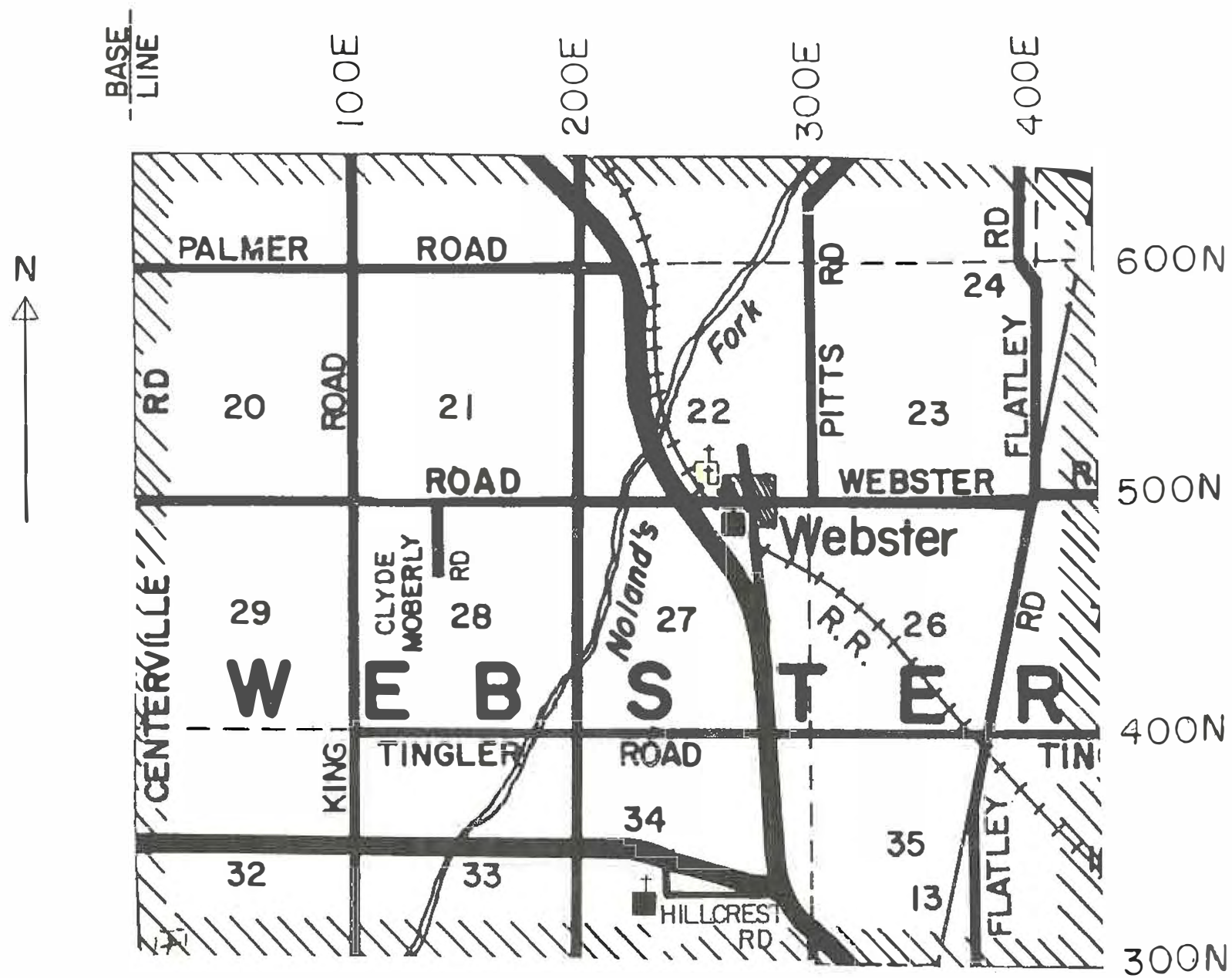

In a small "HISTORY OF BOSTON TOWNSHIP, WAYNE COUNTY, INDIANA", by Lewis M. Starr, published in 1939 is found the following list of cemeteries which existed at one time, early in the settling of the area. (Book is at Morrison-Reeves Library in Richmond, IN.-R 977.263 S796)

It seemed to be a common custom to bury members of the family in a private or family cemetery, located on the land originally acquired from the government.

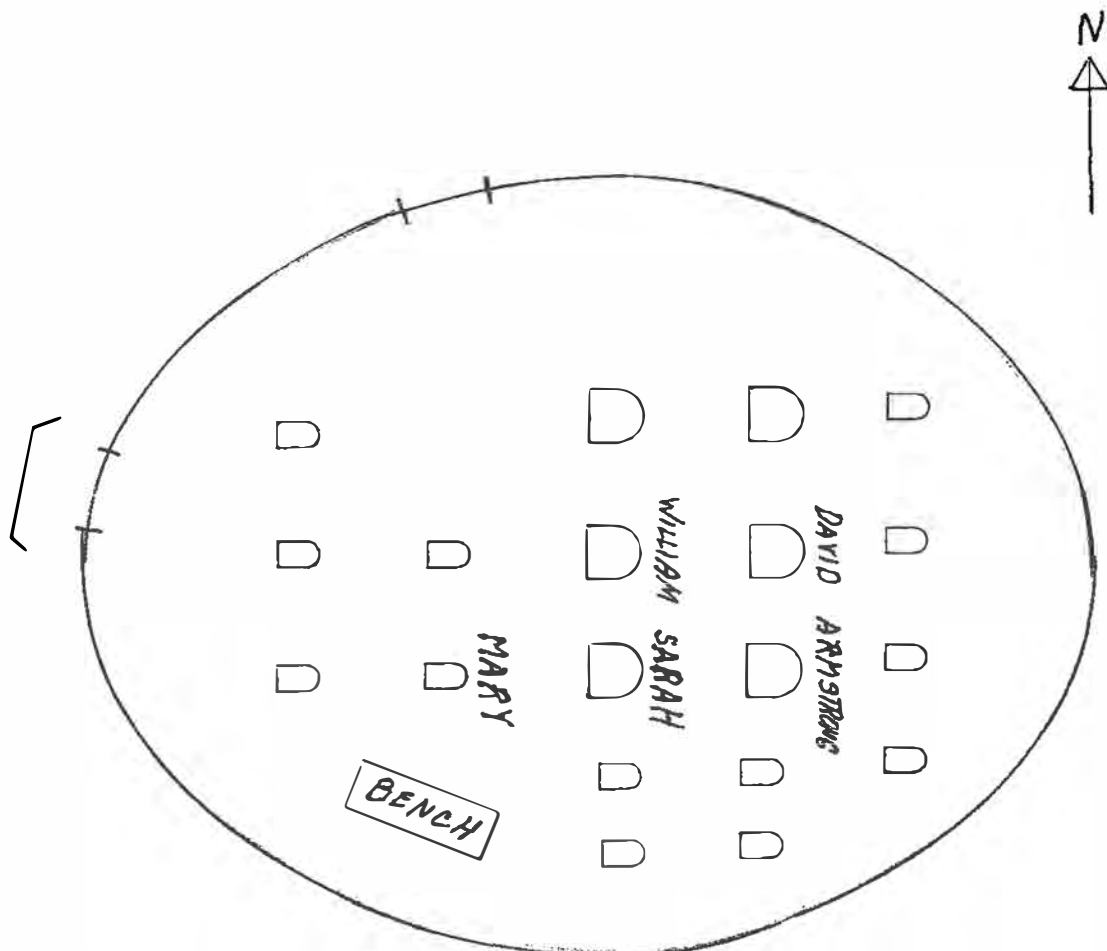
