partly fenced.

Location--West side of State Line Road, southeast of Richmond.

Directions--From U. S. 40-east Richmond: go south on Garwood  
Road to end-go left on Greenmount Road, which becomes  
State Line Road. Cemetery is on right (west) at the jog  
in the road.

Cemetery Governing Body: A small group of neighborhood residents,  
descendants of some of the individuals buried in this  
cemetery.

Brief History & Information: According to Mr. Campbell, this  
cemetery was started by early settlers of the area, some  
of which wished to be buried right on the Ohio-Indiana  
State Line.

The portion of the cemetery which is in the curve of State  
Line Road, is in Ohio, while the rest of the cemetery  
is in Indiana.

A Revolutionary War veteran, John Campbell is buried in  
this cemetery.
